

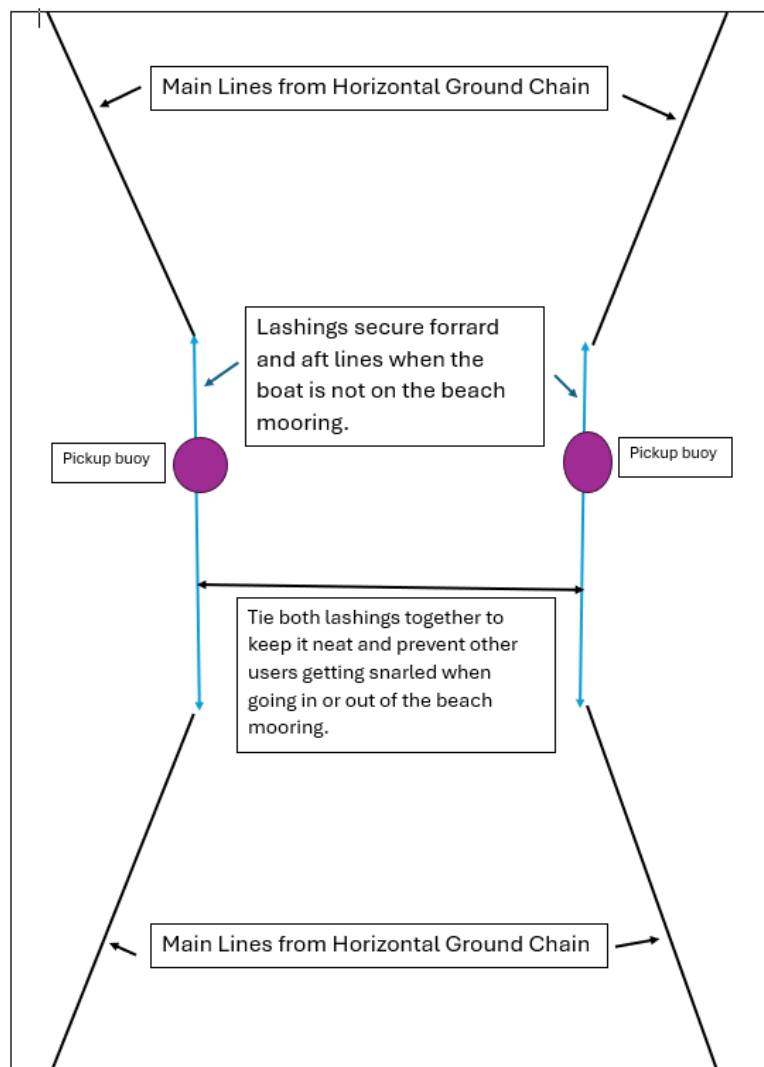

BEACH MOORINGS GUIDE

Following a recent inspection of the beach moorings it has become clear that we need to remove excess chain and rope that is no longer in use. For us to do this, and so there is no confusion as to what is still in use, we are asking that you copy what is seen in the picture below as a guide.



As you move off your beach mooring, we understand that it may be a struggle to get lashings in place to join the four fwd and aft lines, so we advise to go down on the low tide that same day to lash it together. This is the same for coming back onto the beach mooring remove the joining rope on the low tide before to allow for easy pickup of your strops.

We plan to remove leftover/extra ropes from the 20th May so please look to do this soon. Any lines which appear to be not in use or excess will be removed so please ensure your gear is marked accordingly.
